PURPOSE

Metropolitan Tabernacle Fellowship of Ministers exists for the purpose of togetherness in Christian fellowship in an effort to provide a "covering" for others. The "covering" connotes no financial or legal liability but one of prayerful interest in the persons involved by the choice of individual members. Affiliates are urged to pray regularly for those of "like faith" and ministry. Members are encouraged to interact with each other as they choose. The Scriptural ideal of members choosing to be "their brother's or sister's keeper" in prayer and love is certainly one that will be richly rewarded. Sometimes ministry is lonely and the volunteer partnership of commitment in spiritual interest offers a source of strength.

COMMITMENT

Members are volitionally committed to the propagation of the Gospel of Truth found in the Holy Scriptures and set forth in the Statement of Faith. It is understood that individual commitments are the responsibility of each member and therefore are not a reflection on those of any other person. Each member, by their commitment, pledges to conduct life and ministry in an upstanding and holy manner that brings glory to God and enhances confidence in His Church which is the spiritual body of the Lord Jesus Christ. No unscriptural or inappropriate conduct, behavior, action or attitude is to reflect on MTFM, its leaders, or members. This fellowship is not responsible for the attitudes or actions of any of the participants.

CERTIFICATION

<u>Certificate of Ministry</u>: for those responding to the call of God to serve under their pastor in the local church

License: for those who have a definite call to the five-fold ministry, but may not currently be full-time

<u>Ordination:</u> for those who have a definite call to five-fold ministry, proven ministry experience, and are generally

serving in full-time ministry.

Membership: includes those individuals that have received their licensing or ordination through the MTFM.

Additionally, MTFM members can include individuals that currently possess ordination credentials with

another organization or denomination.

- Ministerial recognition will require an accountability check-up relative to the Holy Scriptures and ministerial concepts.
- A report relative to present ministry activities and address will be expected by January 10 each year to keep everyone current in contact. In addition, the annual renewal fee is due with the January report.
- The MTFM is released to acquire background checks relative to moral conduct, financial responsibility etc.
- It is herewith understood that the MTFM bears no ethical or legal responsibility for the failure, errors, actions or attitude of anyone
 given a certificate.

BENEFITS

- A ministerial certificate and I.D. card will be issued
- An invitation to ministry events will be extended with reserve seating
- Ministry network opportunities + internet website link participation (subject to approval)

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be called involving at least one of the five-fold areas of ministry (Eph. 4:11,12)
- Must be active in some area of ministry
- Two references of recommendation from non-family members
- A "set apart" lifestyle
- A burden for people who know Christ and those who do not yet know Him
- A cooperative attitude with the Scriptural goals of the fellowship

FEES

Annual Membership Fee \$25 (Due on or before January 31 each year)

Certificate-Licensing-Ordination Fee \$100 (An additional one-time fee for those seeking ministry credentials)

STATEMENT OF FAITH

THE HOLY BIBLE...We believe in the absolute inspiration of Holy Scriptures given by the Holy Spirit without error, as He moved upon holy men of old. Furthermore, we believe that the church has no authority to establish doctrine or practices contrary to those same scriptures. The Bible holds the words of eternal life and the keys of the Kingdom of God. The Bible shows us God's principles and standards for living; and it is the food that sustains us in all circumstances (John 1:14; 2 Tim 3:16-17; I John 2:5,6).

THE TRINITY...We believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. These three are co-equal and co-eternal. (I John 5:7; Gen 1:26; Isaiah 43:10; Matt 3:16-17, 28:19; Luke 3:22).

THE VIRGIN BIRTH...We believe Jesus Christ was conceived by God the Father, through the Holy Spirit (the third person of the Trinity) in the virgin Mary's womb; therefore, He is the Son of God (Matt 1:18, 23-25; Luke 1:27-35; Isaiah 7:14).

JESUS CHRIST...We believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, the second person of the Trinity. While on earth, he was 100% God and 100% man. He is the only man ever to have lived a sinless life. He was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, performed miracles, died on the cross for mankind and thus, atoned for our sins through the shedding of His blood. He rose from the dead on the third day according to the Scriptures, ascended to the right hand of the Father, and will return again in power and glory. We believe every believer must have a personal and intimate relationship with Jesus Christ, for apart from Him we can do nothing. Each person has a ministry from God that no one else can fill. We are to instruct, teach, exhort, and admonish believers in the ways of God. (Matt 1:23; John 1:1,14; 15:1-5; 20:28; Luke 1:31,35; 1 Cor 15:3; 12 Cor 5:21; Heb 13:5-6; 1 Tim 2:5; 3:16; Isaiah 9:6; Phil 2:5-6).

REDEMPTION...We believe man was created good and upright, but by voluntary transgression he fell; his only hope of redemption is in Jesus Christ, the Son of God (Gen. 1:26-31; 3:1-7; Rom 5:12-21).

REPENTANCE...We believe repentance is the commitment to turn away from sin in every area of our lives and to follow Christ, which allows us to receive His redemption and to be regenerated by the Holy Spirit. Thus, through repentance we receive forgiveness of sins and appropriate salvation (Acts 2:21; 3:19; 1 John 1:9).

SALVATION...We believe in justification by faith. We believe that salvation is free and, apart from any work of man, is a result of the sovereign grace of God (Eph 2:8-9; Gal 2:16; 3:8; 5:5; Rom 5:1; 10:9-10; Titus 3:5; Acts 16:31; Heb 9:22).

WATER BAPTISM...We believe that believers should be water baptized by immersion for the circumcision of our hearts. It is through baptism that we publicly identify with the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ (Matt 28:19; Rom 6:3-6; Col 2:11-14; Acts 2:38).

SANCTIFICATION...We believe in the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the believer is enabled to live a holy life. Godly living and the pursuit of a holy life should be the goal of every believer (Rom 8:5,29; 2 Cor 3:18; 6:14-18; Phil 2:12,13; 3:14; 1 Thess 4:3-8, 5:23; 2 Thess 2:1-3; Heb 2:11; 12:14).

THE HOLY SPIRIT...We believe in the Baptism of the Holy Spirit as a real and personal part our everyday lives and that when we are baptized, we are filled with His Spirit and speak with other tongues as He gives the utterance (Acts 1:5; 2:1-4,17,38-39; 8:14-17; 10:38,44-47; 11:15-17; 19:1-6; Eph 5:18-21; Joel 2:28,29; Matt 3;11).

THE GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT...We believe in the manifestation of the gifts of the Holy Spirit to build and edify the church, demonstrate the validity of the resurrection and confirm the power of the Gospel. He ministers to His people through tongues, interpretation of tongues, prophecy; words of knowledge and wisdom, discerning of spirits, faith, working of miracles, and healing. These gifts operate in harmony with the Scriptures and should never be used in violation of Biblical parameters (Mark 16:15-18; Acts 5:16; Heb 2:4; Rom 1:11,12:4-8; Eph 4:16; 2 Tim 1:5-16, 4:14; 1 Cor 12:1-31, 14:1-40; 1 Peter 4:10).

THE LORD'S SUPPER...We believe in observing The Lord's Supper: a unique time of communion in the presence of God when the elements of bread and grape juice (the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ) are taken in remembrance of Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross (Matt 26:26-29; Mark 16:16; Acts 8:12, 36-38; 10:47-48; 1 Cor 10:16, 11:23-25).

HEALING...We believe healing of the sick is illustrated in the life and ministry of Jesus, and included in the commission of Jesus to His disciples. It is given as a sign, which is to follow believers. It is also a part of Jesus' work on the Cross and is one of the gifts of the Spirit. We have authority over sickness, disease, demons, curses and every circumstance in life (Ps 103:2-3; Isaiah 53:5; Matt 8:16-17; Mark 16:17-18; Luke 10:19; Acts 8:6-7, 10:38; James 5:14-16; 1 Cor 10:4-5; 12:9, 28; Rom 11:29; 1 Peter 2:24).
